Falls Creek Rules

July 1-6, 2024

Clothing and Attire: Sponsors have the final say in all clothing to be worn.

- 1. No tank tops, halters, spaghetti straps, translucent clothing, or apparel that exposes the midriff or any extremely tight clothing.
- 2. Shirts must cover the shoulder! Sleeveless shirts are acceptable.
- 3. No apparel that displays pictures, trademarks or advertising of tobacco, beer, alcoholic beverages, marijuana, or controlled substances will be allowed.
- 4. Shoes and shirts must be worn outside the cabin at all times.
- 5. Swimsuits must either be one-piece or two-piece with a dark t-shirt cover that is to be worn (even during swimming). Additional covering is required to and from the swimming areas.
- 6. Shorts must have a five-inch or more inch inseam and must extend to or just beyond the camper's fingertips. No cheer shorts or shorts/pants with words on the bum. No leggings under skirts or shorts to make up the difference of length. No leggings or jeggings. Jeans or shorts that have holes in them: the holes **MUST** be below the 5" inseam area.
- 7. Dresses and skirts must reach the top of the knee. Extra clothing should be taken for recreation.

Cabin Rules

- 8. Every camper is required to shower with soap at least once a day (more if needed). **YOU MUST USE YOUR OWN TOWEL!**
- 9. There is no ball playing of any kind in the streets.
- 10. No smoking, vaping, tobacco, or marijuana use of any kind while attending Falls Creek.
- 11. No firearms, pocket knives, fireworks or bicycles allowed. Students may bring skateboards/skates, however, they may only be used in the skate park area and must be checked in and left there throughout the week.
- 12. Cell phones are allowed during the week, but with very limited use and only during designated times.
- 13. Leaving the campgrounds or leaving the cabin after curfew without the accompaniment of a sponsor is grounds for dismissal from the camp.
- 14. No outside visitors in the bunk areas.

Worship Attendance

15. Students are required to attend **EVERY** Worship Service and Bible Study. If a camper is sick, he or she will remain in the cabin or nurses' station until they feel well enough to attend the next service. If sickness occurs during the morning, free time will be spent in the bunk area lying down.

Free Time

- 16. Free time will be spent as determined by Falls Creek activities or Prue Baptist Church activities. Students are required to have a face-to-face check in with the sponsors once every free time. Sponsors must see you and know where to find you during free time.
- 17. Students must be in a group of three or more at all times outside the cabin.

Kitchen and Bathroom Duties

18. All students are required to help with kitchen and bathroom cleaning. Sleeping quarters and bathrooms will be inspected daily by the sponsors.

Discipline

23. No PDA will be tolerated.

- 19. Campers will be subject to sponsor discretion. Any misconduct may be grounds for dismissal from camp. If a student is dismissed, the parent/guardian will be contacted and they are required to pick up their child at the camp. This is a 4-hour drive one-way. We will not interrupt our camp for one person's misconduct.
- 20. Any noncompliance will result in loss of free time and restriction to sleeping quarters, the length of which will be determined by the sponsor and camp director.
- 22. No foul/crude language or obscure gestures are permitted at any time. Students will have no warning before discipline will be enforced.
